

GIRLS' EDUCATION – SOCIETY'S EDUCATION

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As is known, the general social task of education is to form knowledge, skills, social experience and moral standards in the younger generation. Accordingly, educating the younger generation involves providing a purposeful educational impact, creating the necessary conditions for the norms of interaction in social life and the requirements for compliance with them.

Rude relationships in the family, a lot of lying, and unpleasant behavior create an unhealthy environment that negatively affects the upbringing of a child.

The behavior of parents plays an important role in raising a child. If a child grows up hearing rude and harsh words from his parents and being beaten, this will negatively affect his nature. Eternal values such as morality, modesty, honor, and faith are an integral part of the rich spirituality of our people. For example, our people attach special importance to the growth of a girl child as a spiritually mature and perfect person. Because it is not for nothing that it is said that the upbringing of a girl child is the upbringing of society.

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As our President noted, the extent to which any society and state is democratic and is determined by its attitude and care towards women. Every mother's lifestyle, behavior, attitude towards colleagues and relatives, her livelihood, and her chastity should be an example to her children, especially to girls.

Parents should be more concerned about their daughters' future. If girls are more involved in household chores and are raised to be good at it from a young age, they will develop skills in cleaning the house, sweeping the yard and streets, sewing, knitting, grocery shopping, cooking, hosting guests, ironing, and many other tasks.

Sooner or later, a girl will be taken to a place other than her family home as a bride. It is important to act in a way that she will not be embarrassed, mistreated, or embarrassed when she goes there. If a girl is polite, polite, and sweet-spoken at home, she will behave in the same way wherever she goes and will gain the respect and honor of her family.

Some parents pamper their grown daughters and keep them away from the worries of home and the difficulties of life. The mother takes all the difficulties on herself. Thus, they raise them to be uneducated, uneducated, and unskilled in any work. A girl child should be hardworking. Gentleness suits girls. Gentleness is one of the factors that express a person's humanity. It is respect and kindness, vigilance and purity. Being serious, calm, gentle and sincere in dealing with others is a high virtue of morality.

In conclusion, the love that flows like a river in a mother's heart is enough to cherish any number of children. It is our duty with you to raise our children, including our daughters, to be hardworking, knowledgeable, highly cultured, intelligent, wise, and capable of leading a family, who will benefit both their mother and society .

But love alone is not enough. It must be accompanied by demandingness. Only then will girls be able to become good housewives, active members of the community, good professionals, loyal daughters-in-law, righteous women, and loving mothers in the future.

That's probably why parents advise their daughters, "Be a good girl, until you have a dowry".

An important aspect of the issue for us is the desire to see the national-spiritual image of a woman in modern development in the sense of social status. The most interesting thing is that instead of the trait of girls avoiding boys and protecting themselves from prying eyes, girls are more likely to be demonstrative than boys. When we heard that not only the bride, but also the groom go to beauty salons on wedding days, we honestly did not believe it. Unfortunately, this situation is becoming more and more common.

We really wanted the discerning reader to understand one more remark.

In the development of women's sports in Uzbekistan, we should not forget about the uniqueness. The fact that women's sports in Europe have become a competition with men's sports can be considered a search for new ways to solve Europe's business problems. In our country, thoughtlessly transferring everything takes away from the national mentality. Participation in sports in areas that are difficult for girls also makes changes in the national image of a girl, which is not in harmony with national values. After all, how can we imagine that Kumush's arms and legs have the muscles of a man, and his behavior is like an “Alpomishona”?! Doesn't this seriously undermine the masculine qualities of Otabek's character?

Nobel Prize winner Ch. Lombraz was right when he said, No one but a woman can cultivate true masculine qualities in a man. A woman makes a man by seeing herself as her own, her protector and breadwinner”. Indeed, a girl's awareness of her gender from the age of three still regulates her relationship with boys. The subtlety of a girl's upbringing in the family is aimed at shaping her relationship with boys. In this sense, if forty years ago a mother would have watched her son at school and told him not to be rude to girls, today she would tell her daughter the same thing.

It is clear that the time has come for a sociological study of the reasons for the annual annulment of marriages in our republic. In this sense, the above evidence confirms the need for specialists in the field of sociology who are capable of conducting adequate scientific research and analysis and who can reveal the factors affecting the development of the state.

We are concerned about the decisive role that girls play in the national status and development of the nation as future mothers and educators. If a girl had such qualities as elegance, kindness, and sweetness, would Kumush's soul be happy? The pillars of the fortress called the family would be strong, and the stability of our state would be ensured. When we say equality of women with men, we should not mean physical equality, but civil equality of women in spiritual and moral relations.

Since goodness and evil are formed in social development, the future of the nation will be overshadowed if girls are not educated. All our national worries and concerns are in gender education. After all, when the great scientist Yu. Harari said, "Armed sheep are more dangerous than armed wolves", he drew attention to the fact that human society relies on its laws. If our contemporaries would pay attention to their daughters and sisters who are going to school or university in the family circle, our wish would come true.

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
